## Unit costs for 2005

### Student contributions

The student contribution for each unit is shown in the unit description.

Students enrolled in Commonwealth Supported places (CSP) in their course make a student contribution (formerly HECS) towards the cost of the units in which they are enrolled. Every unit is assigned to a student contribution band based on the field of education of the content of the unit.

### University of Tasmania student contribution bands and amounts for 2005

#### Band 1: \$3,847

(Per full-time load of 1 EFTSL)

The student contribution is calculated by multiplying the relevant full-time band amount by the weight (EFTSL) of the unit. For example, a unit in Humanities with a weight of 12.5% will have a student contribution of \$480.88 ( $=\$3847 \times 12.5\%$ ).

### Tuition fees

The tuition fee for each unit is shown in the unit description.

Australian students who are enrolled in full fee-paying places will pay a tuition fee again based on the field of education of the content of the unit and the weight of the unit. There are twelve tuition fee bands for 2005.

A tuition fee has been calculated for each unit offered even if no domestic fee-paying students will be enrolled in them. Fee-paying places are predominantly in postgraduate coursework programs.

### Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL)

The EFTSL for each unit is shown in the unit description.

1.0 EFTSL is a measure of the study load, for a year, of a student undertaking a course of study on a full-time basis.

## **Census dates**

The census date for each offering of a unit is shown in the unit description.

The census date is the date on which a student's enrolment is taken to be finalised in each teaching period. HECS-HELP and FEE-HELP debts are incurred and SLE is consumed on census dates. Students must make their up-front payments and submit their request/s for Commonwealth assistance by the census date.
