## Unit costs for 2006

### Student contributions

The student contribution for each unit is shown in the unit description.

Students enrolled in Commonwealth Supported places (CSP) in their course make a student contribution towards the cost of the units in which they are enrolled. Every unit is assigned to a student contribution band based on the field of education of the content of the unit. There are three student contribution bands for 2006. Education and Nursing are national priorities with their student contributions fixed by the Commonwealth Government.

The student contribution is calculated by multiplying the relevant full-time band amount by the weight (EFTSL) of the unit. For example, a unit in Humanities with a weight of 12.5% will have a student contribution of \$490.00 ( $=\$3920 \times 12.5\%$ ).

### Tuition fees

The tuition fee for each unit is shown in the unit description.

Australian students who are enrolled in full fee-paying places will pay a tuition fee again based on the field of education of the content of the unit and the weight of the unit. There are ten tuition fee bands for 2006.

The tuition fee is calculated by multiplying the relevant full-time band amount by the weight (EFTSL) of the unit. For example, a unit in Humanities with a weight of 12.5% will have a tuition fee of \$1,250 ( $=\$10,000 \times 12.5\%$ ).

### Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL)

The EFTSL for each unit is shown in the unit description.

1.0 EFTSL is a measure of the study load, for a year, of a student undertaking a course of study on a full-time basis. The standard EFTSL for units is 12.5%. A standard full-time load is eight units (8\*12.5%= 100%).

### Census dates

The census date for each offering of a unit is shown in the unit description. A full list of [census dates](#) is also available.

The census date is the date on which a student's enrolment is taken to be finalised in each teaching period. HECS-HELP and FEE-HELP debts are incurred and SLE is consumed on census dates. Students must make their up-front payments and submit their request/s for Commonwealth assistance by the census date.
